About The Woodland Education Centre

Situated in a beautiful wooded valley in East Devon, the Centre is managed by the Offwell Woodland & Wildlife Trust. The 50-acre site has seven miles of walks open to the public, and provides a number of important habitats for vulnerable British wildlife; for example, dormice, water voles, birds such as the kingfisher, amphibians, butterflies and

dragonflies. A number of wetland habitats have been restored, including a lake, several ponds, streams and a leat. There is also an area of lowland heath, open meadowland as well as a wide range of deciduous and coniferous woodland.
