The Jurassic Coast World Heritage Site is probably the area of greatest bio-diversity in all the British Isles. Rod Lawrence will be providing a commentary throughout the cruise. He will describe the three geological periods of the Jurassic Coast, the plants and animals that lived in those times and why the periods changed during catastrophic periods of climate change. He will also explain the ecology of the wildlife found along this part of the coast, birds, flowers and who knows what else? Sometimes we find dolphins and the giant sunfish. This is such a wonderful place!
